R-CALF’S BULLARD HAS A PEASANT MENTALITY JEWISH PACKERS CRASH MARKET ANOTHER \$15 cwt OR \$30 cwt IN TWO WEEKS

If R-Calve’s Bullard is truly sincere about reducing imported meat, why doesn’t he address the problem? I have never heard him bitch about the World Bank, International Monetary Fund (IMF), or Bank of International Settlements. These aristocratic Jews, who run the money systems, set the value of currencies and govern the price of meat exported out of and imported into the countries. Their game plan is to rape the third world countries (steal their meat) and sell the meat to the United States, who they propagandized as having a strong dollar, because they set the rate and decided it is strong. This way,



as they no doubt claim, they are making money coming and going - buy cheap, sell high.

The laborers of the third world countries continually complain about the price of their meat, and that they cannot afford to buy it. ISRAEL WANTS MORE KILLING FIELDS

Last week a man went to Umpqua Community College in Roseburg, Oregon and asked students what their religion was. If they were Christian, he killed them. If they were non-Christian, he shot them in the legs. When the bloodbath ended, nine people were dead and more others wounded.

Before the day was over, the Organization again blamed guns for the violence. They repeated the same tirade of erroneous facts in calling for stricter gun control laws, claiming that more

killing fields (gun-free zones) would curb mass shootings and gun violence in the future.

Australia is a test-tube example of what happens when you confiscate guns. After 1996, here’s what happened:

Murders committed with guns increased by 19%.

Civic Assn. In Birmingham, NY, Northern Illinois University, shopping mall in Omaha, Virginia Tech, shopping mall in Salt Lake City, Amish schoolhouse in Nickel Mines, PA, Red Lake High School in MN, Luby's restaurant in Killeen.

The one constant in all of them is gun-free zones.

[As an aside, why do Obama's kids attend a school that is a "gun free zone" with at least 11 armed guards on campus at all times?]

The Organization claims that law enforcement (no longer peace keepers) favors gun confiscation. Milwaukee County Sheriff David A. Clarke, Jr., does not agree. He says, "We should get rid of these gun free zones. We should allow people, under circumstances, you know, concealed carry license holders, to be able to play a role in their own safety. I think it's heartless to expect people in these gun free zones to be lined up and slaughtered with no way to defend themselves. These gun free zones have become killing fields. That is the one constant in all of these mass murders including the military recruiting section where the President of the United States doesn't even trust soldiers stateside to go armed."

As a technicality, Upqua university is not a

gun-free zone. In 2011 a state court decision prohibited public colleges from banning guns on campus. There was an effort to pass a new law to reinstate the ability of public colleges to ban guns. That measure was defeated.

However, by the power of propaganda, everyone, including criminals, think it is a gun-free zone, and an opportunity to massacre.

Air Force veteran John Parker, who had a licensed concealed carry gun on his side, was situated in a building about 200 yards away from where the shooting began at Umpqua Community College. Instead of taking down the active shooter, Parker was prevented by staff from intervening in the shooting in which ten people were killed.

So, yes Oregon law does allow CCW on public property. But, that doesn't stop institutions from trying to keep people from carrying, or preventing the idiots from getting in the way of someone trying to help.

The Lame Stream Press does not report the far greater number of times when a crime is prevented by the presence of a gun.

HONOR & DISHONOR & THE LAW

This is the most important aspect of the law. In law, "Honor" or "Dishonor" is a process. It is what is done in response to a presentment. Throughout the entire process you must be in honor. This applies to everything you do in the legal process. To act with dishonor toward the other person is the highest sin in any system of law.

High Principles

"In ancient times, honor was the manner of being that we now describe as having integrity. In plain language, an honorable person avoids deception whenever possible, treats others with respect and sticks to her beliefs no matter how others think or act." ~Carla Joy

In Practice

3 ways to honor a presentment

1. Accord & Satisfaction

2. Conditional Acceptance
3. Rejection Without Dishonor
- 2 ways to dishonor a presentment
4. Argument
5. Silence

In practice, after the 1st Party (P1) makes a presentment, the 2nd Party (P2) does one of the following:

HONOR

1. Accord & Satisfaction: P2 Honors by accepting the presentment without recourse, and then satisfies whatever is demanded in the presentment. Example: P1 presents a bill for services; P2 pays the bill.

2. Conditional Acceptance: P2 Honors by accepting the presentment but with conditions. Effectively, that is a counteroffer from P2 to P1. [P1 would then accept the counteroffer as a new presentment from P2.] Example: P1 offers his house for sale; P2 accepts the offer provided that the house is first painted.

3. Rejection without dishonor: P2 rejects the presentment because it is defective. Example: P1 presents a bill for services; P2 returns the bill because there is an error (perhaps the price is wrong), but will accept the bill once the error is corrected.

DISHONOR

4. Argument: P2 rejects (dishonors) the bill. There is no basis for rejecting the bill; the arguments

have no relevancy to the presentment. Often, ad hominem (irrelevant comments against P1) accompany the rejection.

5. Silence: P2 simply does not respond to the presentment, but remains silent. The presentment is thus dishonored.

PROCEDURE

Before Going to Court

1. P1 makes a presentment to P2. If P2 honors the presentment, P1 acts accordingly. So long as each party honors the other's presentments, the process can move forward to resolution.

2. If P2 dishonors P1, then P1 grants grace and repeats the presentment.

3. If P2 dishonors P1 a second time, P1 then makes an affidavit of the history of presentments. The affidavit is given to a notary public. The notary is requested to make, in behalf of P1, a formal presentment to P2.

4. If P2 dishonors the presentment, the notary grants grace and repeats the presentment.

5. If P2 dishonors the notary a second time, the notary makes a certified history of the presentments. The history is given to P1.

6. At this point P1's and P2's administrative process are complete. The affidavit of P1 along with the certificate of the notary, now becomes the basis for a court action against P2.

In Court

You can think of the court process as a formal series of presentments. Each time a presentment is made (i.e. a court paper is filed), the responding party

has an opportunity to honor or dishonor the presentment. The response, whether honorable or dishonorable, in turn becomes a presentment.

Your objective is to never dishonor the other party's presentment. If the other party persists in argument or silence, you can stay in honor by refusing his arguments for cause, stating the cause, and giving him an opportunity to cure the defects. If he refuses to stop arguing, you stay in honor as he continues in dishonor.

Parens Patriae

Parens Patriae originates from the English common law where the King had a royal prerogative to act as guardian to persons with legal disabilities such as infants, idiots and lunatics. In the United States, the parens patriae function belongs with the states.

At least in theory, two reasonable but contending people will honor each other and attempt to resolve the problem at hand. In actual practice, often one or the other or both will act in dishonor.

If both are acting in honor, the court has nothing to decide, for the parties will work it out together. If one of the parties is in dishonor, then the court must look with favor toward the person who is in honor. If both parties are acting in dishonor, the doctrine of parens patriae becomes effective.

When both parties are in dishonor, either because they are arguing or confused or silent, the state now has full power to invoke parens patriae to control the affairs of the apparently incompetent litigants (idiots).

The market at Crawford was as good as anywhere on October 2nd, especially, when comparing Torrington and St. Onge Friday sales. Comparing a few representative sales:

500 wt. blk. Steers

Steve Wadhams, Mitchel, Neb. brought \$225; Haymaker, Harrison Neb. brought \$220.00 at Crawford, where as, Shepperson, Upton, Wyo. Brought \$211, and Olson, Broadus, Mt. brought \$213 at St. Onge. So, it looks like the Crawford steer market was \$10 cwt. Higher than St. Onge.

Eighty year old Herb Hraska, who comes out of hibernation in the fall, and Casey Wilmont kept the 400 to 500 wt. heifer market active at Crawford. It was \$10 to \$20 higher than St. Onge. For instance Grimm blk/bwf 500 wts. brought \$192 at Crawford, but at St. Onge a typical sale like Hulett's Cold Creek Ranch bwf hf. or Riley/Malli, Arvada Wyo. brought \$178. Wilmont was paying in the \$205 to \$210 range for the 450 wts.. At St. Onge the 450 wts. brought \$185-187, see Bulkley Ranch, Gillette, Wyo. and Ruby Olson, Broadus, Mt. heifer sales.

It appears the open yearling heifer market was also \$10 higher. Mick McCarthy from Alliance and going farther south bought the top load. The ZX Bar Ranch 8 weight heifers brought \$178 at Crawford, while at St. Onge 8 weight heifers from Crago Land & Livestock brought 169.75.

It is the same story every week on bulls. Crawford bull market seems to always be \$5 higher than Torrington. USDA reported bulls brought from \$94 to \$110 at Torrington. Your publisher bought a load of bulls at Crawford for an avg. cost of \$108.5. By the way, your Publisher did spend \$163,871.46 at Crawford this week, and spent zero dollars at Rushville and Torrington Livestocks. That extra buyer always helps the market.


